The William C. McElheran was built circa 1847 and was purchased in 1860 and used for construction of gun carriages for the confederacy.

This house features and interesting history including a massive renovation featured in a 1977 Post and Courier article about historic renovations. Of course the home has been updated and renovated since then. The main floor features a foyer with a formal living room with fireplace to the right and a Living room/den with fireplace to the left. The updated kitchen is beyond the den and features custom cabinets, stainless appliances, and granite tops. A powder room is also located off of the kitchen. Downstairs is currently configured as two bedrooms and a bath (giving a total of 4 bedrooms), but features it's own entrance and could easily be used as a Mother-in-Law Suite with a separate small kitchen. Upstairs features two bedrooms each with it's own updated bathroom and fireplace. The walled outside courtyard provides the perfect place to relax in the afternoon.
